Profile of the college

Patidarrang College is the premier institute of Higher Education in Nasatra, Kamrup (R) district of Assam. It was established on the 31st day of August, 1989 by a team of selfless and untiring social workers and lovers of education of the greater locality with the aim to make higher education accessible to students in the remote interiors of Assam.

The college is situated in a place with best road transport connectivity at Nasatra - Muktapur on Baihata Chariali - Goreswar PWD Road. It is college of excellence in Arts stream.

ADMISSION INFORMATION

- * Prospectus and Application Forms are available in the college office on payment of Rs. 250/- (Rupees Two Hundred Fifty) only.
- * Admission to the college is strictly on merit basis and subject to the approval of the principal Admission Committee.
- * Students who have passed HSSLC Examination from Patidarrang College (Jr.) will get preference in the admission of degree course.
- * There is reservation of seats for ST, SC, OBC, MOBC and physically challenged as per govt. rules. A few seats are reserved for the students having outstanding performances in co-curricular activities. These seats are allotted on merit cum proficiency in the concerned field. Candidates have to submit valid documents from the competent authority if they apply under these category.
- * Candidates are required to produce original mark sheet of last qualifying examination, admit card and original pass certificate from the Head of the institution last attended and caste certificate (if applicable) at the time of interview. Physically challenged students must produce the necessary certificate from the competent authority to that effect. Students, who passed qualifying examination earlier than the current year, must submit a gap certificate regarding their activities during this period to the satisfaction of the authority.
- * Students can apply for Major if he/she secures 50% marks in the concerned subject.
- * Admission will be deemed cancelled if the student continuously absents in the class.
- * Admission to the college takes place on the day of the interview on payment of the necessary dues.
- * Regular classes will start as per notification by the principal.
- * All admissions are provisional and subject to the approval of G.U.

A Summary of the GU UG-CBCS†

What is UG-CBCS?

The undergraduate degree (UG) programme in the Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) will have courses spread across six-semester of any undergraduate degree course. Two consecutive (one odd and one even) semesters will make up an academic year. An UG course shall be of Six Semesters covering three Calendar Years (Academic Sessions – June to May). The duration of the Odd Semesters (First, Third, and Fifth) shall be June - November, and that of Even Semesters (Second, Fourth and Sixth) shall be December - May.

How does it work?

The courses in GU UG-CBCS are categorised primarily into three types of courses - Core, Elective, and Ability / Skill Enhancement courses. All the core and elective courses will comprise of six (6) credits and the skill courses are of four (4) credits.

Core Course

As the name suggests, a core course is a necessary course that a student MUST take in order to complete the degree. The number of core courses for Honours and Regular degrees are different.

Elective Course

An elective course is the one for which a student has some kind of freedom to choose from a pool of courses. There are two kinds of elective courses - Generic and Discipline Specific. The generic elective courses are those, which can be chosen by a student belonging to any stream, while the discipline specific elective courses are particular to only the discipline concerned. However, a student pursuing an honours degree course can choose a generic elective from any other discipline except from the honours course itself.

Ability / Skill Enhancement Course

An Ability or Skill Enhancement course is aimed at providing the student with skill and ability. These courses have four (4) credits each in contrast to the core or elective courses. The ability enhancement courses MUST be opted by a student and the student can choose papers from a pool of skill enhancement courses.

Dissertation / Project

A student can opt (subject to conditions) a dissertation or a project work in lieu of a 6-credit discipline specific elective course in the sixth semester.

The Notion of Credit

A student needs to earn a required number of credits in order to successfully complete a degree. The credit is closely related to the number of stipulated classes a student has to complete. The following table indicates the number of credit a student can earn for each type of indicated classes.

ACADEMIC RESOURCES AND FACILITIES:

LIBRARY :

The central Library of the college has at present a stock of 12500 books. the working hours of the library is from 10 a.m to 4 p.m It has a good collection of books both syllabi prescribed and other reference books. GENERAL INFORMATION

Academic session

The academic session 2019-20 starts on 1st July, 2019 to 30th June 2020 in semester system and 1st semester ends in December 2019, 2nd semester starts in January 2020 and ends in June, 2020. This is in conformity with the regulations of Guwahati university to which the college is affiliated.

Attendance

It is obligatory to every student to attend the classes punctually and regularly. attendance of a student in the Degree Course must not be less than 75% of the total lectures delivered in an academic year, as per G.U. Norms. Promotion to appear in final exam a student must quality the minimum attendance as per norms.

College Hour

The working hour of the college is from 9-00 a.m to 4-30 p.m.

The class hour is 9-00 a.m. to 4-15 p.m.

Identity card

An identity card is issued to every student at the time of admission. It shall contain information of the holder along with a recent passport size photograph duly endorsed by the principal. the student must keep it and should be ready to produce it whenever asked for. identity card is not transferable.

Student's Union

Patidarrang college student's union is the General Body of the students of the college. All the regular students of the college are the members of the union. The principal of the college is the president of the Student's union. If necessary the principal may appoint an Asst./Asso. professor as the working president. office-Bearers of the Student's Union are elected by the students annually by an election committee constituted by the principal. the Election Committee consists of one teacher as returning officer and three other members from the teachers for smooth conduct of the student's union election every year. The principal reserves the right to dissolve the Union Body at any time on disciplinary ground and constitute an ad-hoc body till fresh elections is held.
