Data Collection and Analysis

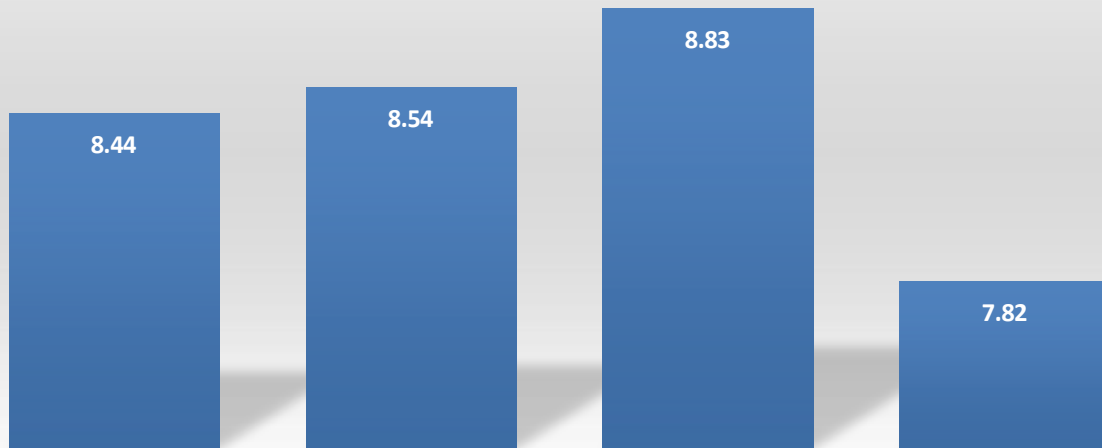

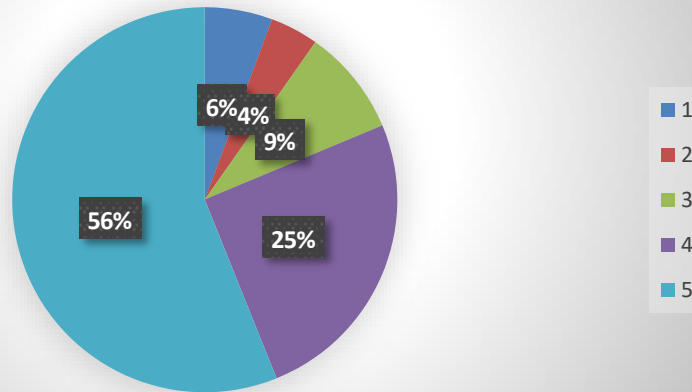

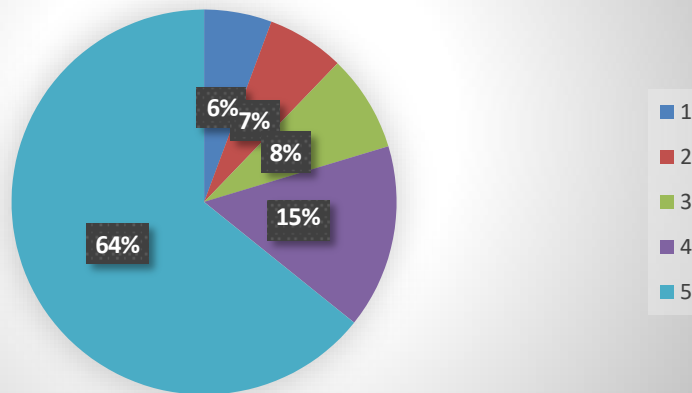

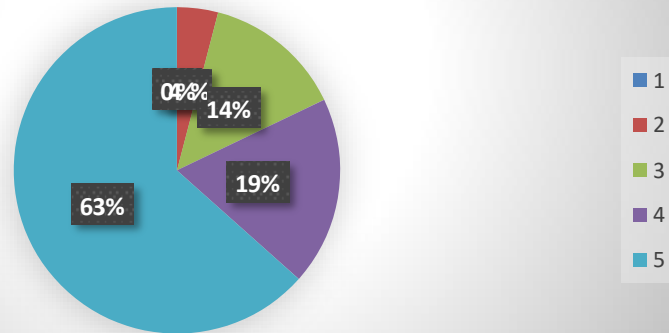

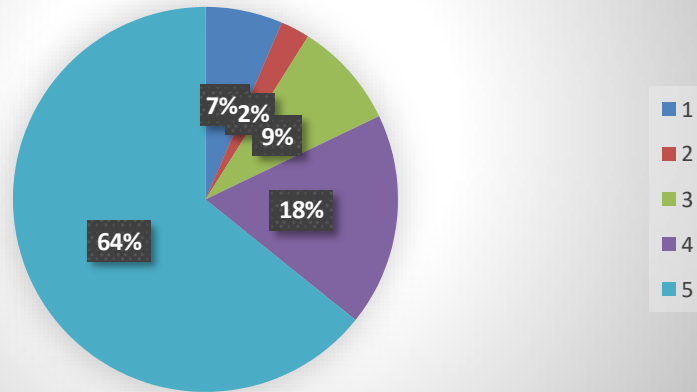

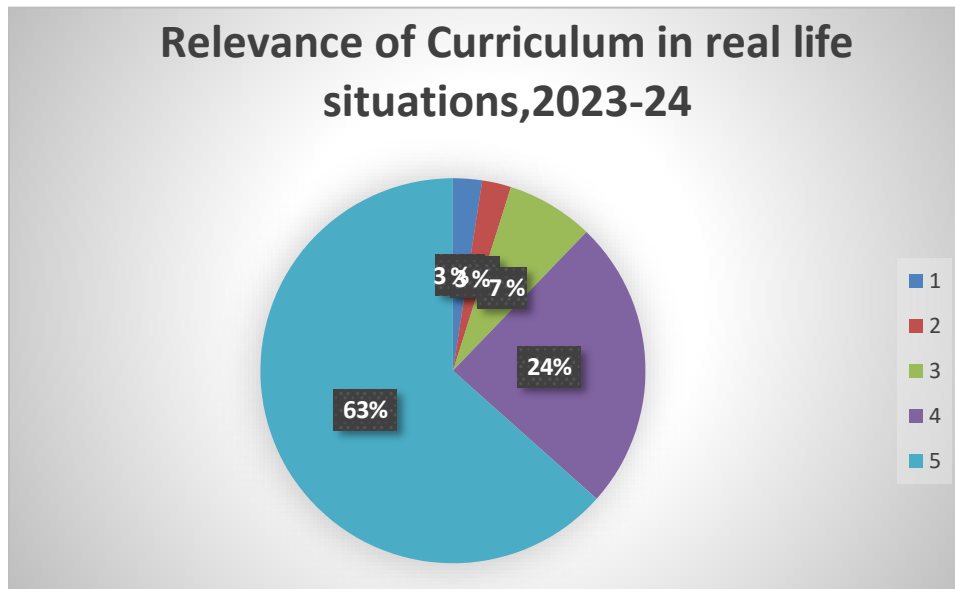

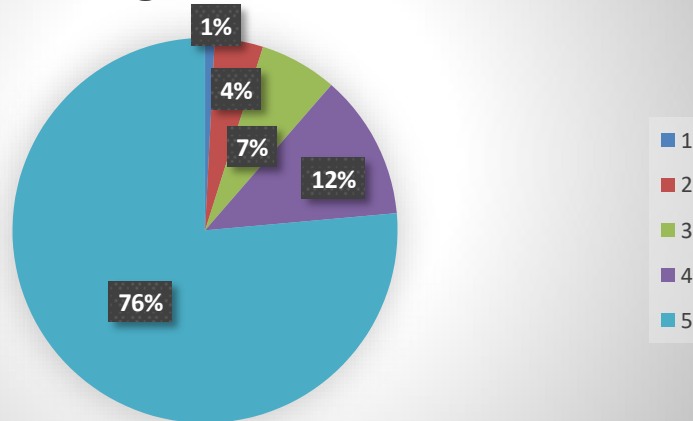

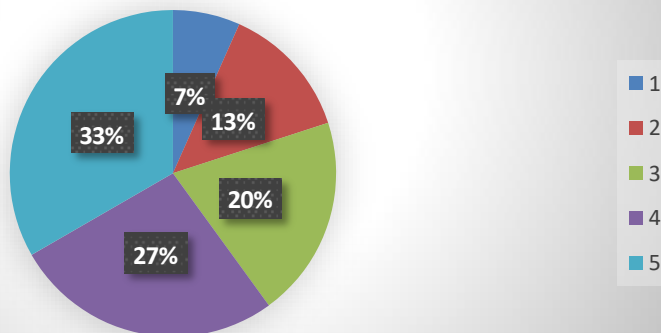

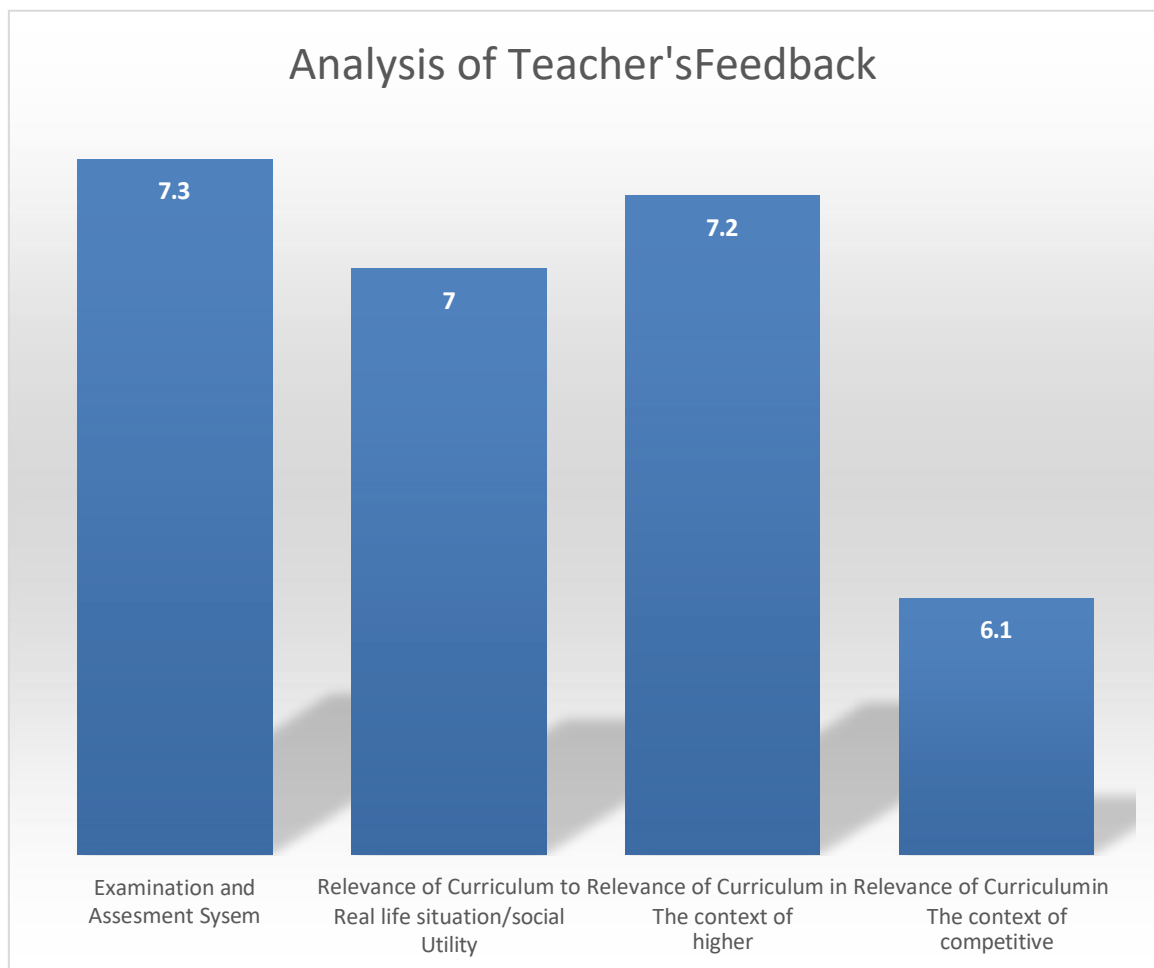

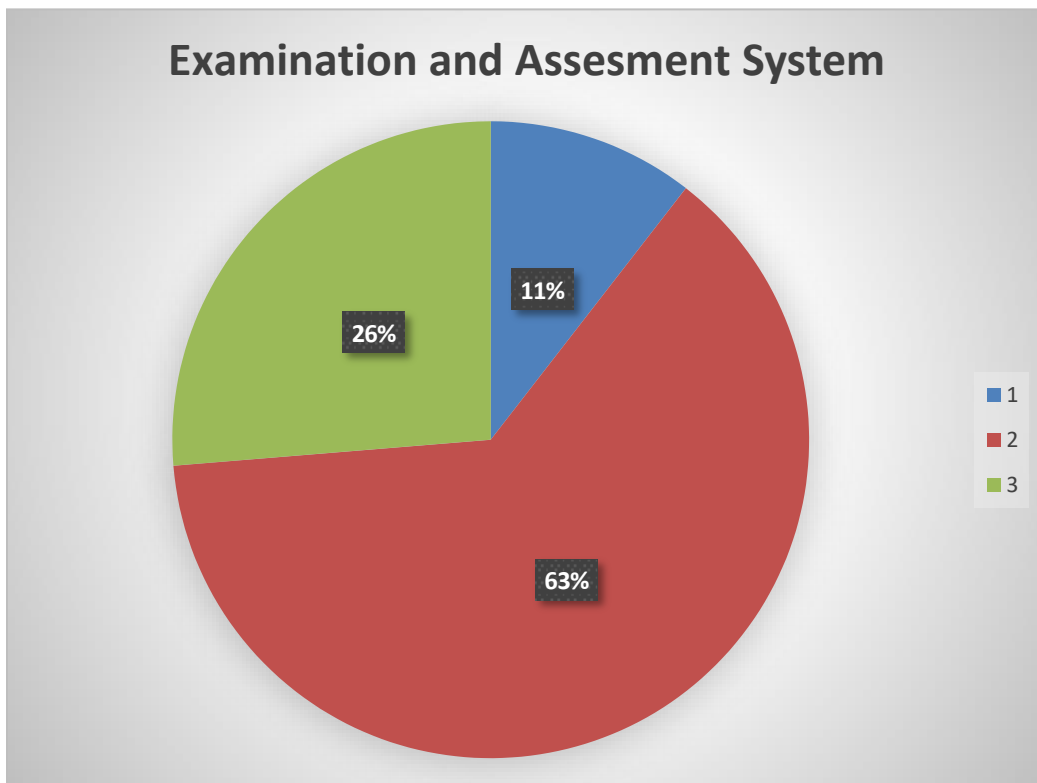
Analysis of Teacher's Feedback on Curriculum

The Marks out of 10 in an average can best be described through the following Bar Diagram.



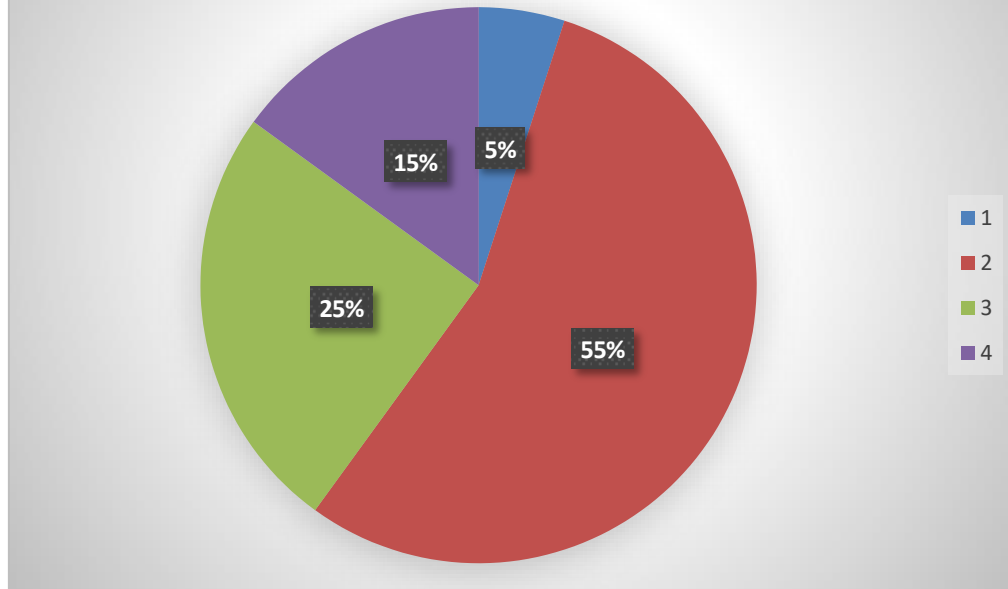
The percentage teachers that allotted marks one a chat tributes are shown below.

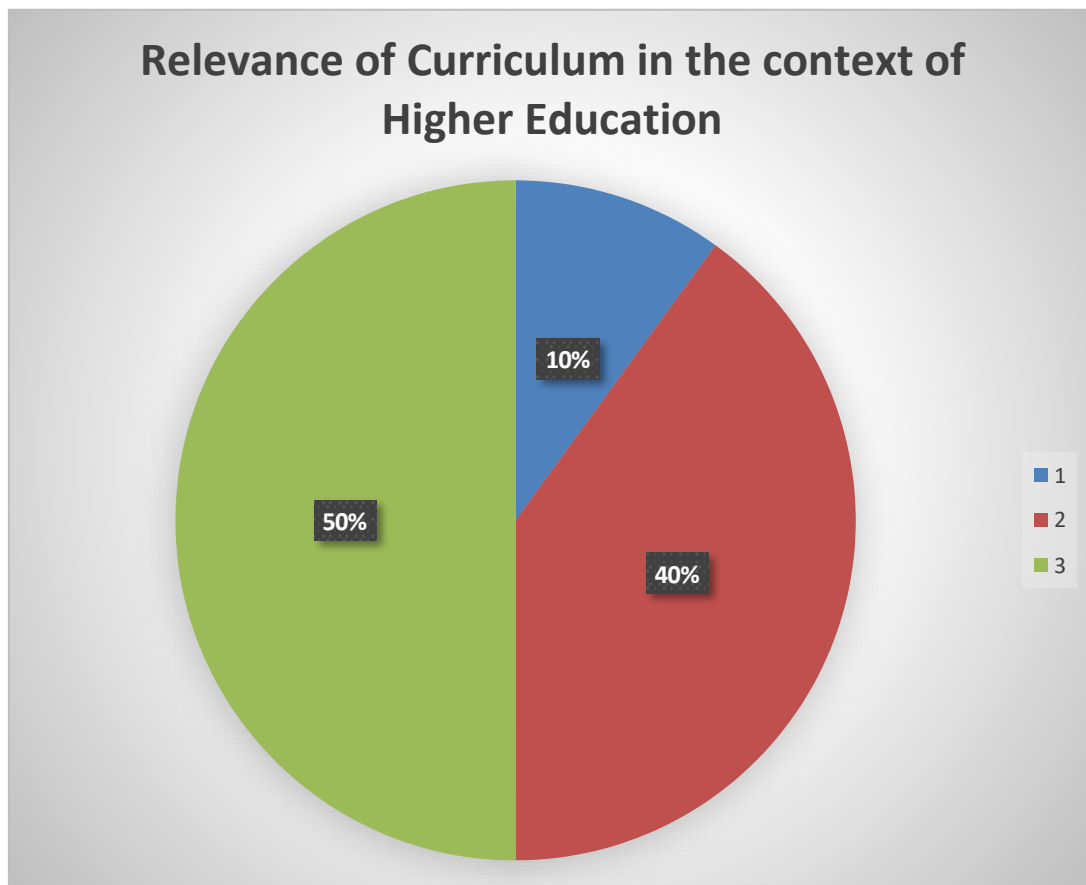

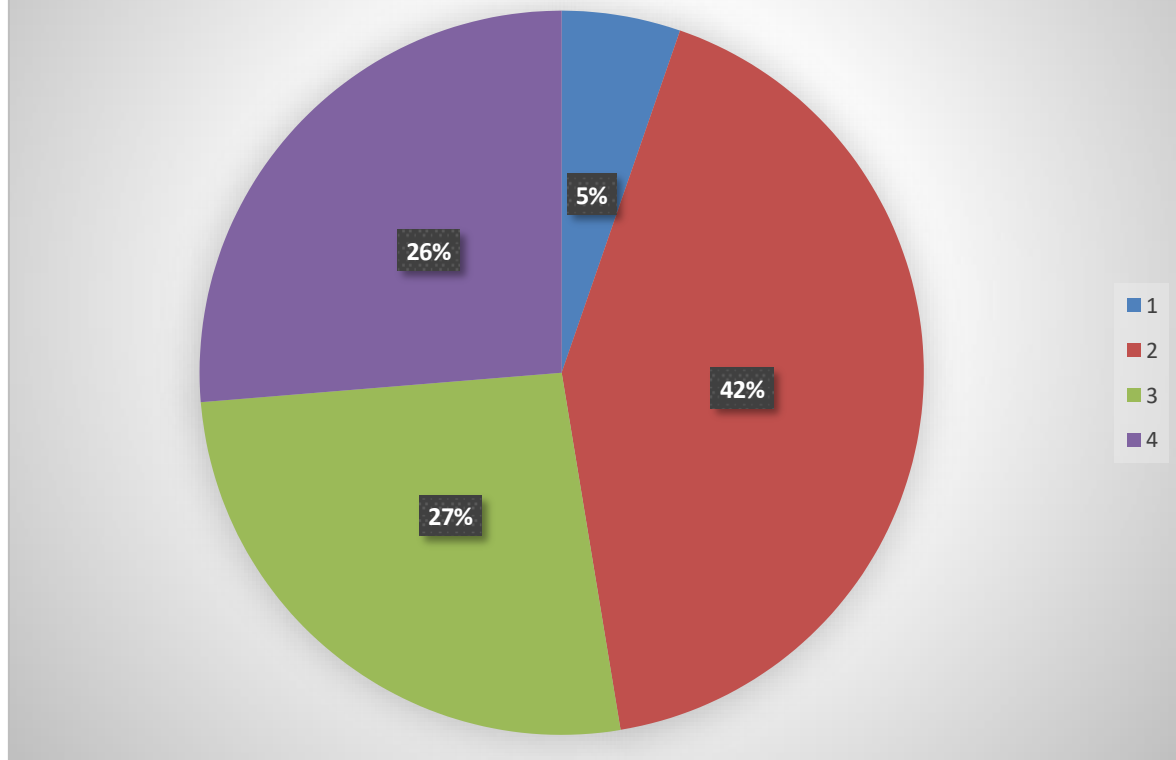

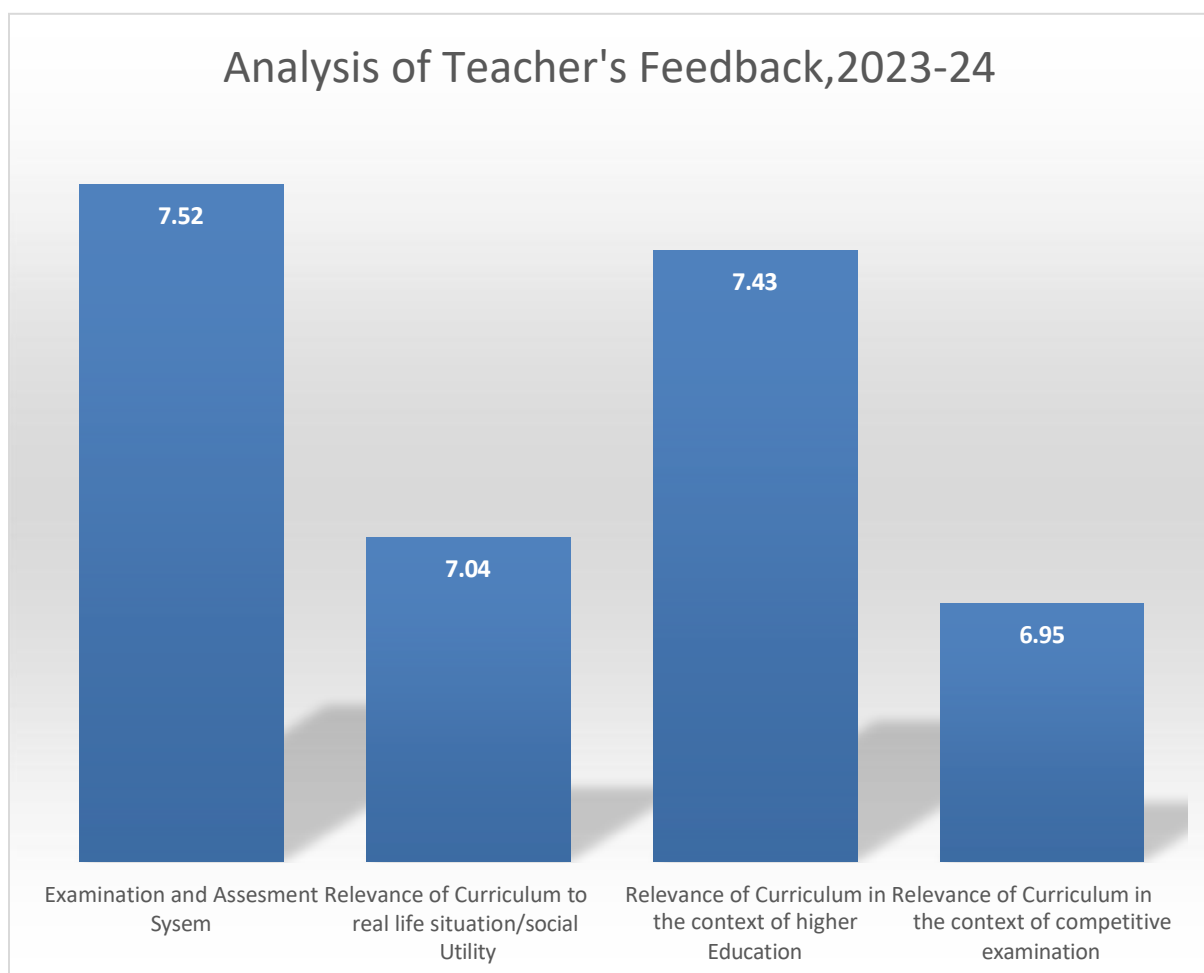

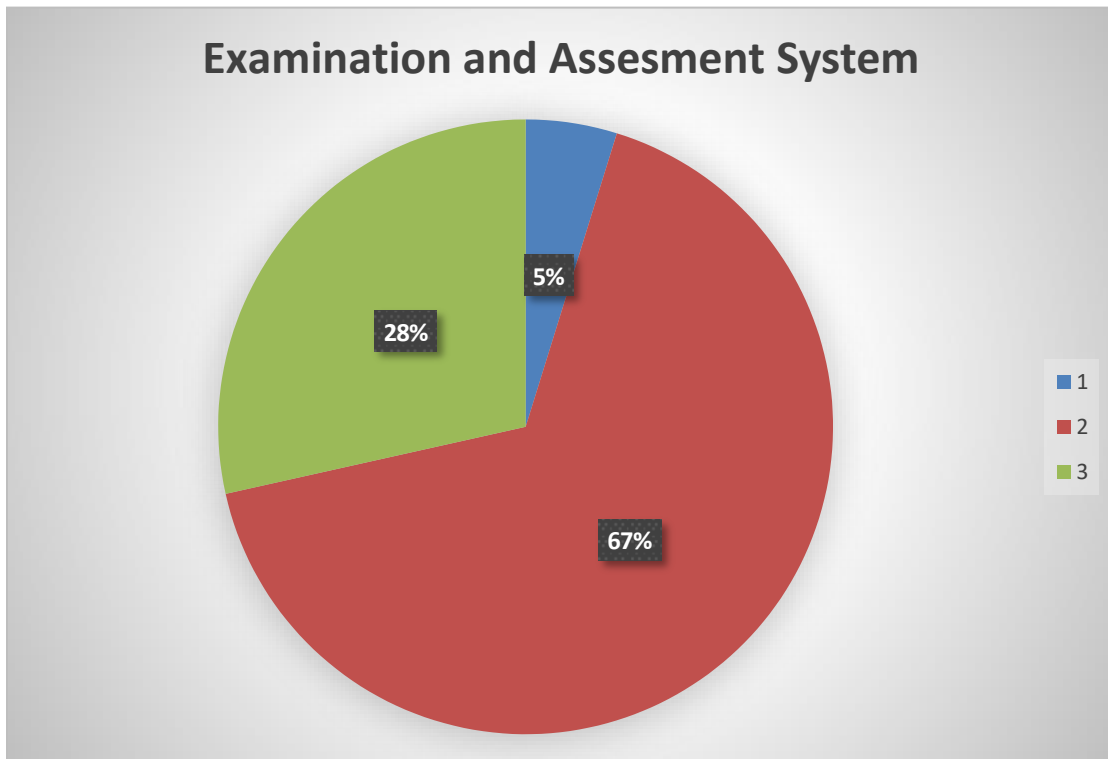
Analysis of Teacher's Feedback on Curriculum

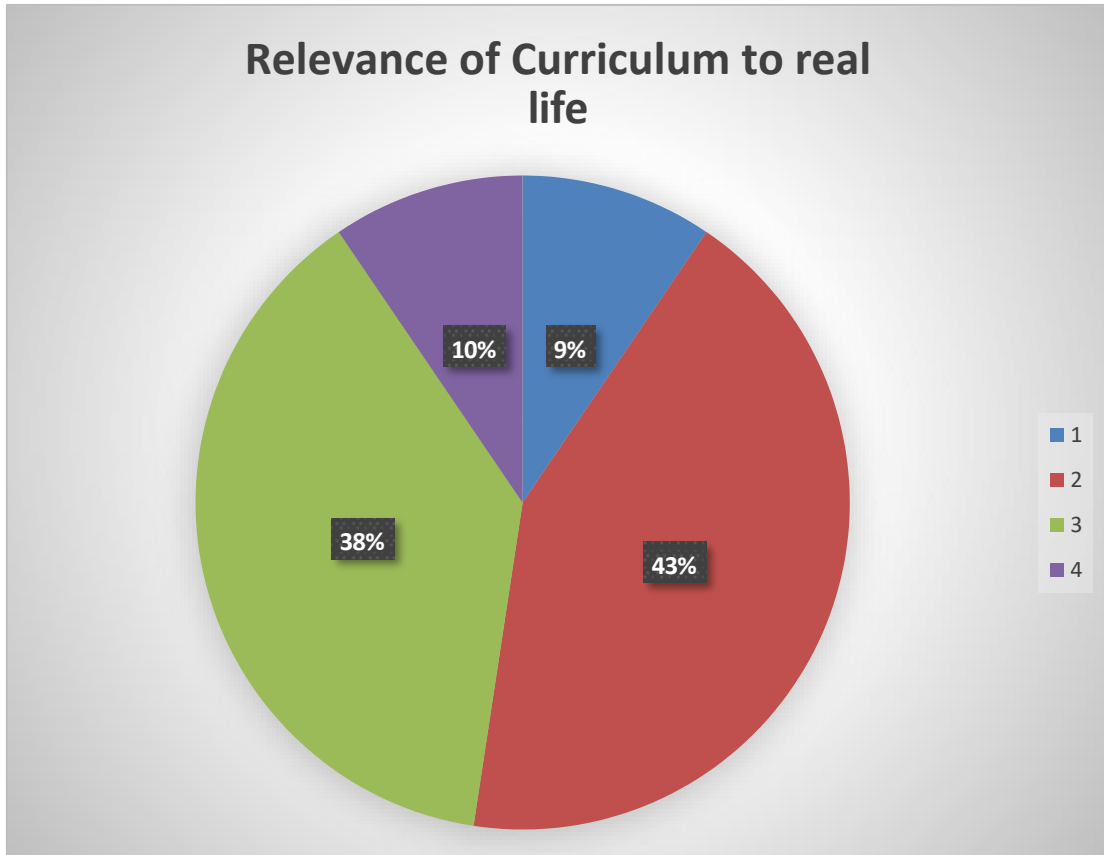


The percentage teachers that allotted marks on a attribute are shown below.

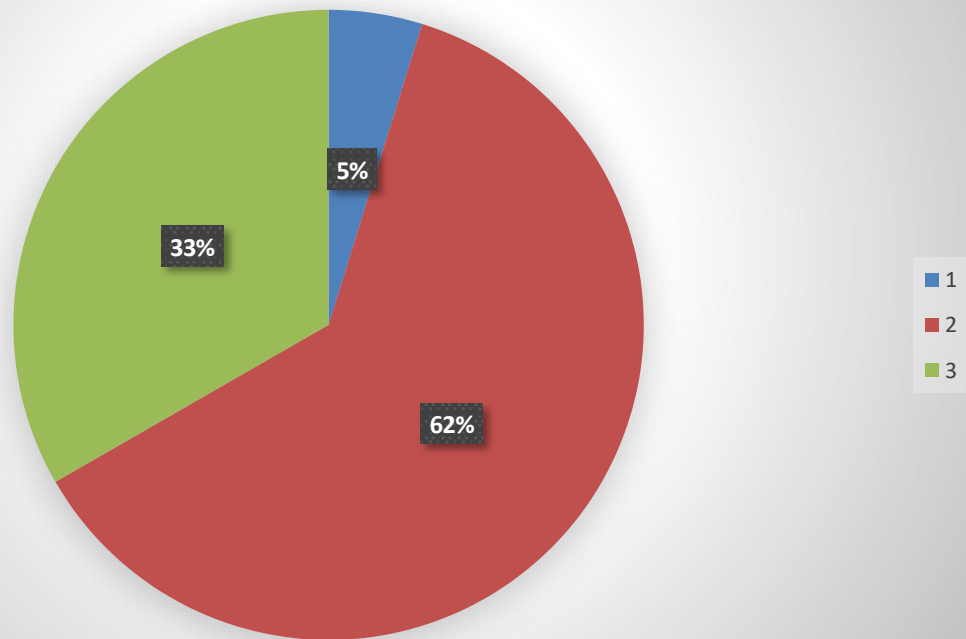

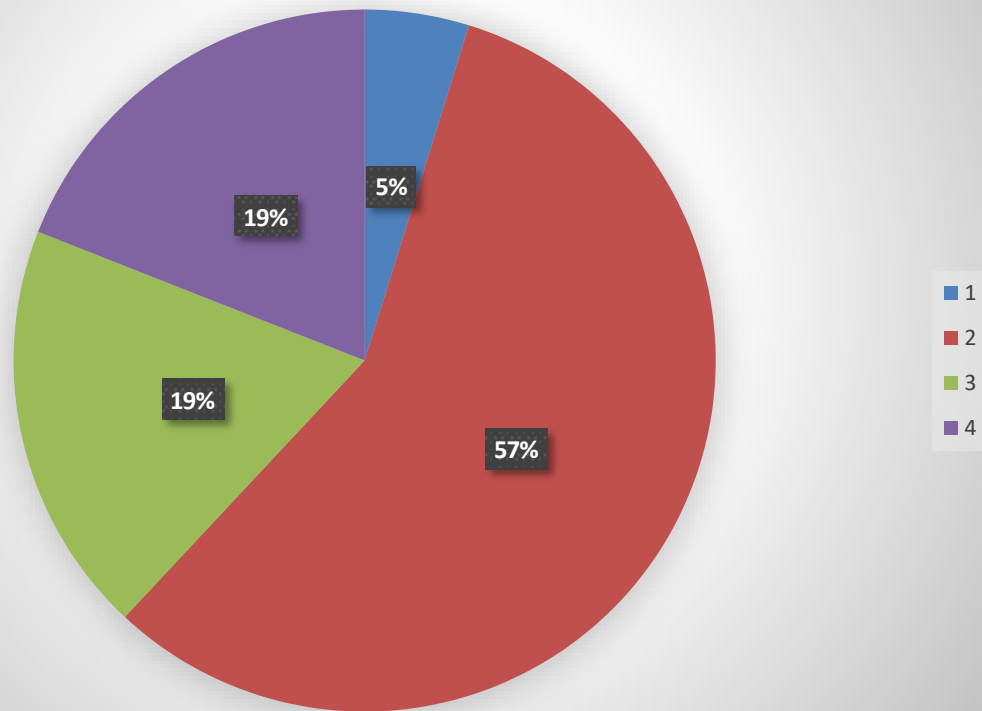
